Applications must be submitted before 11:59 PM, Monday, April 19, 2021 to <u>naccash@hotmail.com</u>. <u>DO NOT</u> <u>SUBMIT VIA FACEBOOK OR OTHER SOCIAL MEDIA.</u>

Late applications will not be considered! Please note: email time stamps can vary and cannot be controlled. It is strongly recommended that applicants do not wait until the last minute to email. The time used will be the <u>received</u> time, not the sent time.

Awards decisions and notifications will be made no later than April 30, 2021. Formal check presentations will be made at the final performance of the Summer Show.

Steps to apply for a Drama Club Scholarship

- 1. Be accepted for admission to a college, university, or post-graduate trade school.
- 2. Complete the Drama Club Scholarship Application.
- 3. Include your résumé and cover letter. The résumé should include all theatrical experience and experience with other organizations or businesses. Include all volunteer positions, paid positions, and positions of leadership. Cover letter is a brief letter of introduction.
- 4. Write an essay of 500-2000 words telling how the Drama Club influenced you and/or the community. If you choose to write about the community, do NOT attempt to speak for any one person, but rather discuss an overall effect the Club has had on the Parish or the Warren County/Front Royal community. The essay may not be handwritten.
- 5. Questions should be submitted in writing to Mrs. Naccash, <u>naccash@hotmail.com</u>. Please include your first and last name.

Awards

- Winning applications will receive \$500 scholarships. Additional smaller scholarships may also be awarded.
- Recipients will be chosen from among all eligible applications by a selection committee appointed by the St. John's Drama Club Board. Teen Board representatives will not be involved in the selection process since they may be eligible to submit their own application for the scholarship.
- Funds will be paid directly to the winning applicants to be used at their own discretion.
- Winning essays may be published in the Parish bulletin and on the Club website and may be used without restriction in other Club publications.
- The names of club members who are awarded a scholarship will be listed on the Drama Club website and may possibly be included in the Parish bulletin.
- Applicants do not have to be <u>current</u> Club members but must have been <u>active</u> Club Members at some time.

Please Note

- Applicants will not be considered for a Drama Club Scholarship until they have been accepted for admission to a college, university, or trade school.
- Applicants do not need to major in theatre to be considered for a Drama Club Scholarship.
- Applicants must be 20 years old or younger on May 31, 2021.
- Applicants may only receive a Drama Club scholarship once.
- Applicants must attend the school of their choice in the Fall or following Spring semester of the Award year. If you will not be attending school immediately, please postpone your application.
